As of 21.3.21: Rapid Testing for Green Pass Activities

Businesses will be able to order fast test providers from an approved list that will be published on the Ministry of Health website.

The Minister of Health, Yuli (Yoel) Edelstein, the Director General of the Ministry, Prof. Chezy Levy, and the Corona Commissioner, Prof. Nachman Ash, agreed that starting this coming Sunday, March 21, 2001, the rapid testing system will take effect. The Ministry of Health together with the ministries of Finance, and Economy have been working together to find a way to maintain rapid testing prices at reasonable levels.

The rapid test system is expected to be used for entering Green Pass activities, as a complementary method to the entry of vaccinated and recovered patients, in a manner separate from national PCR tests.

Entry to Green Pass activities will be allowed for the vaccinated, recovering, and people who present a negative test from a rapid test conducted on the spot only. To be clear: A normal negative PCR test will not be allowed.
