Overall there were no major health concerns reported. Her Excellency the Sowi Lyonpo, visited the various vaccination posts in Thimphu after the COVID-19 vaccination launch at Lungtenzampa. Towards the end of the day, Lyonpo and the health officials including the National Immunization Technical Advisory Group (NITAG) met for a debrief to strategize for the second day. The Executive from the MoH who were deployed in different dzongkhags to oversee the implementation also joined the debrief virtually to update on the Day 1 vaccination across the country. This was mainly done to understand the field reality as well as to improve the vaccination services delivered to the general public in the coming days.

While the first day of COVID-19 vaccination ended successfully today, the Ministry of Health would like to request the general public to continue with the solidarity shown this far.
