

## The Togolese Government's measures

### Measures taken by the Government - August 24, 2020 ()

As part of monitoring the evolution of the COVID-19 pandemic, in accordance with the recommendations of the Coordination of the Management of the Response against the Coronavirus and the scientific committee set up by His Excellency the President of the Republic Faure Essozimna Gnassingbé, to fight against this pandemic, it has been noted in recent weeks, a worrying increase in cases of new coronavirus infections throughout the national territory and particularly in the following localities: Sokodé, Tchamba and Adjengré.

Having noted that the infected people have had many contacts and in order to prevent this spread from increasing further within the populations of said localities and throughout the country, the government decides on the following to count from tomorrow August 25, 2020:

1. the closure of the towns of: Sokodé, Tchamba and Adjengre;
2. the establishment of a curfew from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. in the prefectures of Tchaoudjo, Tchamba and Sotouboua.
