

## The Togolese Government's measures

The government is informing all air transport users of the reopening of Togolese air borders and the resumption of domestic and international flights as of Saturday, August 1, 2020

Arrangements have been made to guarantee air transport users and populations travel conditions that comply with the recommendations of the government, the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) and the International Air Transport Association ( IATA)

The government is informing airport operators and all users of international flights that they will now have to fill in a form available on the site <https://voyage.gouv.tg> (<https://voyage.gouv.tg>) . The embarkation and disembarkation of passengers in aircraft are subject to the mandatory completion of the said form.

In addition, all passengers bound for Togo, except those in transit, must be subjected to the Covid-19 PCR test: a single test on arrival and another departure. The cost of a test is forty (40,000) CFA francs. These fees are payable when registering on <https://voyage.gouv.tg> (<https://voyage.gouv.tg>) .

Passengers departing from Togo must undergo a Covid-19 PCR test within 72 hours before their departure. The results of these various tests are delivered to interested parties by SMS and by email within 24 hours.



In addition, to allow the security and health authorities to ensure compliance with the quarantine to which all travelers are subject, they must install, on their arrival at Lomé airport, the TOGO SAFE mobile application. This application, which will soon be available on the Play Store and in the App Store, will give them the possibility to define the place of self-containment of their choice.

The government invites all travelers to strictly comply with these provisions, in order to allow safe air flights during this period of the Covid-19 pandemic.

It is also recommended that all travelers inquire about the conditions of entry, transit or stay as well as the health protocols in place in their country of destination with the competent authorities, in order to avoid any inconvenience. .

Failure to comply with the provisions and measures put in place exposes offenders to the penalties and fines provided for by the regulations in force.
