In an address to the nation on April 1, 2020, the Head of State Faure Essozimna Gnassingbé declared a state of health emergency for a 3-month period and announced new measures as part of the response against the coronavirus (Covid-19). Find below, the essence of these different measures:

### Security measures

- Implementation of a curfew as of April 2, 2020 between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Creation of a special anti-pandemic force composed of 5,000 men.

### Sanitary measures

- State of health emergency for a period of 3 months.
- Establishment of mobile laboratories for screening within the country.

### Social measures

- Launch in the coming days of a cash transfer program for the most vulnerable.
- Free water and electricity for social sections for 3 months



- Readjustment of civil servants' working hours from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
