In order to implement all the necessary measures likely to prevent the spread of the coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19) in our country, the President of the Republic, as part of the implementation of the state of The health emergency decreed on April 1, has set up and this, as of April 2, 2020, a curfew from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. applied in Grand Lomé.

Based on the results of the epidemiological study carried out in Grand Lomé from 23 April to 08 May 2020 by the Scientific Council, a study which consisted of a systematic screening of the populations most exposed to the disease, it emerges a stabilization of the spread of the epidemic in Grand Lomé.

Consequently, the Government decides on the one hand, that from Sunday May 10 the curfew will start from now on at 9 p.m. and end at 5 a.m. and on the other hand, that the working hours will be held between 8 a.m. hours and 4 p.m. starting Monday, May 11.

The Government seizes the opportunity to remind the entire population of the imperative need to continue by respecting all the barrier measures and those of the other provisions aimed at containing the pandemic in our country.
