### PUBLIC HEALTH ACT [CAP 234]

#### Declaration of Public Health (Amendment) Order No. 24 of 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by subsection 21A (2) of the Public Health Act [CAP 234], I, the Honourable SILAS MELVE BULE, Minister of Health, make the following Order.

#### 1 Amendments

The Declaration of Public Health Order No. 6 of 2022 is amended as set out in the Schedule.

#### 2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is made.

## SCHEDULE

### AMENDMENTS OF DECLARATION OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 6 OF 2022

**1 Paragraph 3(f)**

After "travellers", insert "is limited to returning citizens, residents, students and essential workers, and;"

**2 After paragraph 3(k)**

Insert

"(ka) all retired health care workers must be re-engaged to assist with the COVID-19 operations;"

**3 Paragraph 3(l)**

Repeal the paragraph, substitute

"(l) The following persons supporting the repatriation, quarantine or isolation operation must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19:

- (A) a healthcare worker; and
- (B) a person who works at the Ministry of Health; and
- (C) a frontline worker; and
- (D) the Chairperson and the members of the Teaching Service Commission; and
- (E) the employees of the Teaching Service Commission; and
- (F) the Commissioner and members of the Police Service Commission; and
- (G) the members of the Vanuatu Police Force, and
- (H) the Chairman and members of the Public Service Commission; and
- (I) the employees of the Public Service Commission; and,
